



Business Horizons, a program of the Iowa Association of Business and Industry Foundation, is a one-week, hands-on summer program offering high schools students business, financial literacy, economics, leadership, entrepreneurship and teamwork training for their future in business world. A vital role at Business Horizons is the mentorship of on-campus adult volunteers called **Industry Advisors.**

What is an Industry Advisor?

An Industry Advisor is a loaned business executive, business owner or other interested adult who provides direction and leadership for a team of high school students who attend Business Horizons. Business Horizons is a one week hands-on learning experience, which focuses on economic education, leadership and personal skill development ... where the “bottom line” is **FUN!**

Details

The program will be held at Simpson College from **July 20-25, 2008**. Over 100 high school students from across the state of Iowa will attend. Ten to fifteen students will team up to form an ‘Industry’. We plan for each Industry to have two Advisors. If you are new, we will attempt to partner you with an “experienced” Advisor or some people prefer to choose their own partner.

We will provide a complete training session on **Thursday, June 19th**, from approximately 10am-3pm, at our ABI Foundation offices, 9th and Walnut, downtown Des Moines. This session will be a crash course where you will be fully trained on team-building activities and how to lead your Industry. It also provides a nice “get acquainted session” for all of the Advisors. There is an orientation on **Saturday, July 19** from 10:30am-3:30pm which advisors are required to attend. You and a guest will be invited to join us for dinner afterward.

The hours are grueling but will be some of the most **FUN** and important hours of your year. From July 20-25 you will need to be awake and ready to roll from 7am to about 8pm, depending on the day’s activities. July 25 is Graduation Day ... we finish around 2:30pm. During the program dates we will provide you a **free** room at Simpson (if you wish to stay on campus) and meals. We’ll even splurge and take you to Adventureland one night!

Role

You will facilitate your Industry’s team meetings and team building activities. You’ll assist your Industry with the operations of the business simulation (*don’t worry, we’ll show you how*) and guide them through the development of their financial strategy and marketing plan. You will help prepare them for their investor presentation, infomercial and trade show. You will also motivate them and create a team that supports one another in order to reach a common goal. But always remember ... the “bottom line” is **FUN!**

You don't need prior experience in the business, finance or marketing field ... only the desire to learn and to help others.
